

Cookie Policy

1. Introduction and scope

FlatTurtle, with registered office at Ikaroslaan 1, 1930 Zaventem, Belgium and registered with the Crossroad Bank for Enterprise with enterprise number 0843.961.762, uses cookies on her website <https://flatturtle.com/> (the “**Website**”).

By means of this cookie policy, FlatTurtle wishes to inform you about how and for which purposes it uses cookies and similar technologies.

FlatTurtle reserves the right to amend this cookie policy at its own discretion and preferences. Where appropriate, you will be notified through a pop-up on the Website.

2. What are cookies and similar technologies?

Cookies are small pieces of information in the form of text files, created by a program on the server of the Website, which are then placed on the hard drive of your computer or mobile phone when you visit the Website. These cookies are able to uniquely and unambiguously identify your device and/or browser session. However, the cookies themselves are not capable of searching your computer or creating viruses.

3. What cookies do we use?

On the Website, we only use necessary cookies. These cookies are essential since they are strictly necessary for navigating the Website and using the functionalities offered. These cookies cannot be refused by the User of the Website.

4. For how long do the cookies remain valid?

Session cookies will only be retained for the duration of your current browser session. When you quit this browser, the cookie is deleted automatically.

Persistent cookies remain valid until their expiry date, unless you delete them earlier.

5. First and third party cookies

First party cookies are cookies set by the Website of FlatTurtle you are visiting and only the Website is able to read them.

Third party cookies are placed on your device by another party when using the Website.

6. How to control cookie use and delete them?

Most web browsers allow the control of the cookie usage and the cookies present via the browser settings.
